The Faroe Islands has implemented some of the harshest aquaculture legislation in the world in order to ensure that the highest levels of fish welfare and sustainability are met.

The aquaculture industry in the Faroe Islands has a long and proud history dating back to 1968. Our heritage combined with the constant pursuit of quality has resulted in an aquaculture industry which today is modern, innovative and extremely competitive.

The industry is also well consolidated; today there are only 5 companies producing and exporting salmon from the Faroe Islands, they all share the goals of sustainability and producing salmon of the highest quality.
